


## Health and Safety Policy Statement

### General Statement of Policy

In accordance with the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and the Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 2007, CNM's general policy is:

- To provide adequate control of health and safety risks arising from our work activities
- To consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- To provide and maintain safe plant and equipment
- To ensure safe handling and use of substances
- To provide information, instruction and supervision for employees
- To provide the health & safety law leaflet
- To ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training
- To prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health
- To maintain safe and healthy working conditions
- To provide a first aid box and accident book
- To ensure that our construction Clients are aware of their responsibilities under CDM (2007)
- To avoid foreseeable risks to health and safety in preparing and modifying designs
- To co-operate and co-ordinate with project teams to improve the way in which hazards are eliminated and any remaining risks are managed and controlled
- To ensure that designs relating to any structure that will be used as a workplace will meet relevant requirements of the Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992
- To review and revise this policy and related procedures as necessary at regular intervals
